

SOUTH CAROLINA'S CROFT STATE NATURAL AREA

Croft State Natural Area is a big park with lots to do. A green retreat in the heart of fast-growing Spartanburg County, the park offers 26 miles of mountain biking and hiking trails, a playground, picnicking and camping, as well as fishing and boating in two lakes, including 165-acre Lake Craig.

Croft also is known around the region for its equestrian facilities. The park regularly hosts shows in its arena and boasts 27 miles of equestrian trails and 51 stalls.

The diverse park was once an Army training base and is made up of rolling, wooded terrain that also provides habitat for a wide variety of flora and fauna just five miles from bustling downtown Spartanburg.

Pets: Pets are allowed in most other outdoor areas provided they are kept under physical restraint or on a leash not longer than six feet.

Admissions: \$2/adult, \$1.25/ SC Seniors, free for age 15 and younger

Driving Directions: From I-85: Take exit 78. Get on Hwy. 221 and take Hwy. 176 to Country Club Rd. Turn right on Country Club Rd. Turn left at the light (Hwy. 56). Stay on Hwy. 56, turn left onto Dairy Ridge Rd. and follow signs.

From I-26 Southbound: Take exit 22, go east on Hwy. 296. for approximately one mile, turn onto Hwy. 295 until it intersects with Hwy 56. Turn right onto Hwy. 56, then take a left at Dairy Ridge Rd. and follow signs.

From I-26 Northbound: Take exit #52 onto Hwy 56. Go N for 30 miles. Turn right onto Dairy Ridge Rd. And follow signs.
