

The residual 12 frauds reported during FY 2014-2015 were nominal in nature and indicative of Executive Branch employees operating in a high integrity environment given its \$25 billion budget and 66,000 employees.

South Carolina's metal recycling industry is strong, with the second highest number of steel mills in the Southeast. The state's three mills include two at the Nucor Corporation, located in Darlington & Berkeley Counties and one at CMC Steel in Lexington County. More than 11 million tons of iron and scrap steel are produced each year and 70% of this is recycled. South Carolina local governments reported earnings of more than \$2.6 million from the sale of metal in 2014.

South Carolina currently has more than 85 companies that are involved with paper recovery and recycling. This includes four paper mills that employ about 2,700 people, while recycling nearly 1 million tons of paper annually.

Electronic Nicotine Delivery Systems (ENDS) are currently not regulated by a governmental agency. Nonetheless, these products are being included in smoke-free and tobacco-free initiatives across the country, meaning they are banned anywhere there is a policy prohibiting the use of tobacco products. Many S.C. municipalities and businesses with smoke-free ordinances have amended their policies to prohibit ENDS. In keeping with this trend, the S.C. Department of Health and Environmental Control will also include a ban on ENDS in all A Healthier State tobacco-free campus efforts.


