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SPECIFIC SKILLS INSTRUCTOR DEVELOPMENT

Class Limit: For all classes held in field 25. Classes held at SCCJA 20. Most classes are held in the field.

Course Description:

This course is designed for officers who have been selected by their departments to instruct an already approved lesson plan in a specialized area within their department. Upon completion of this course, officers will be able to instruct already approved lesson plans in the areas of basic, advanced, in-service, pre-service, etc. within their agency. This class is a prerequisite for instructing Firearms, Driving, Radar, Ground Defense, Defensive Tactics and other instructor related courses at the Academy.

This course covers areas such as: lesson plan preparation, training needs assessment, training liability, methods of instruction, adult learning and positive instructor techniques. Officers who complete this course will be accredited by the South Carolina Criminal Justice Academy as a Specific Skills Instructor.

Who Should Attend?

Only Class 1, Class 2, or E-911 certified telecommunicators who have been selected by their department / agency to be an instructor in a specific skills area can register to attend this class. Officers attending this class are required to bring an already approved lesson plan from their department to instruct from.

Proficiency:

Officers must achieve a minimum score of 70% on a 15 minute instructional presentation in order to pass the course.
