- Bicycles should travel with the flow of traffic.

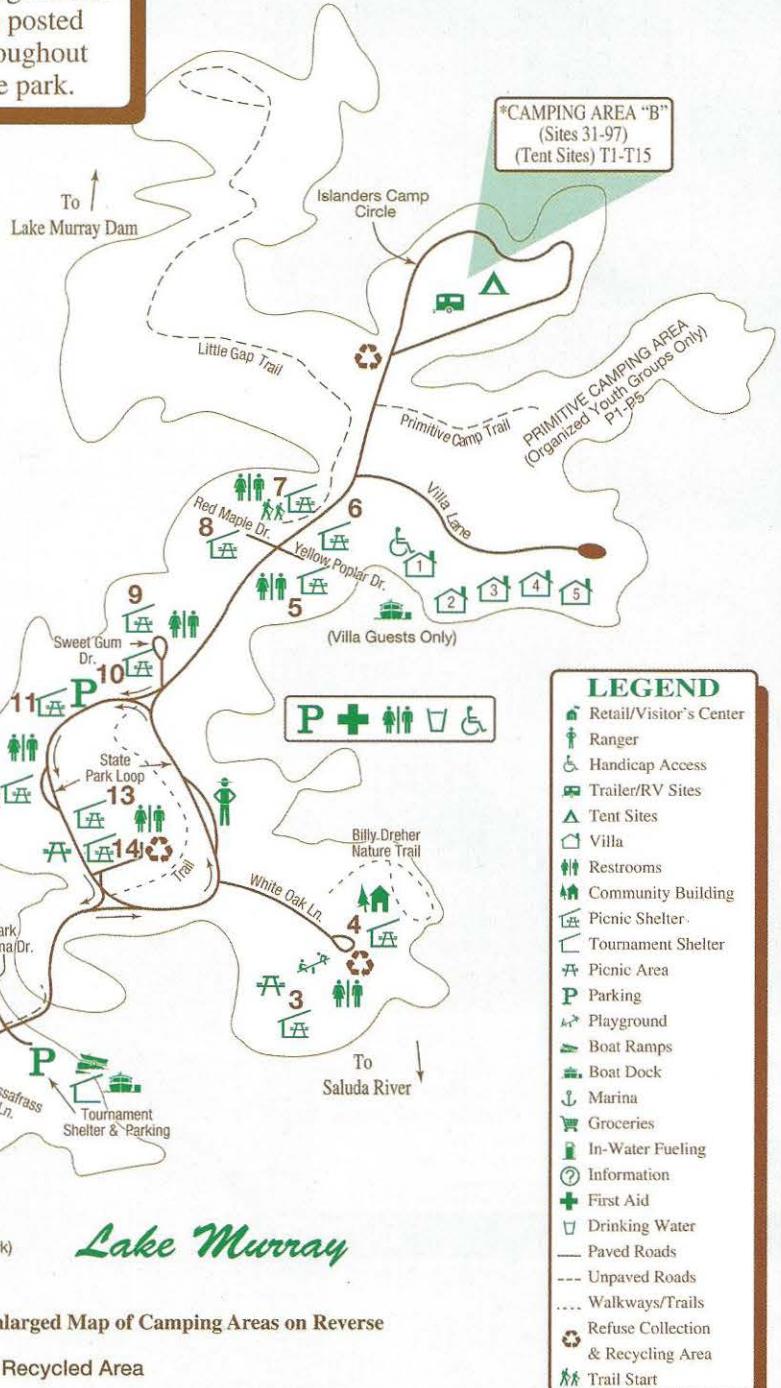

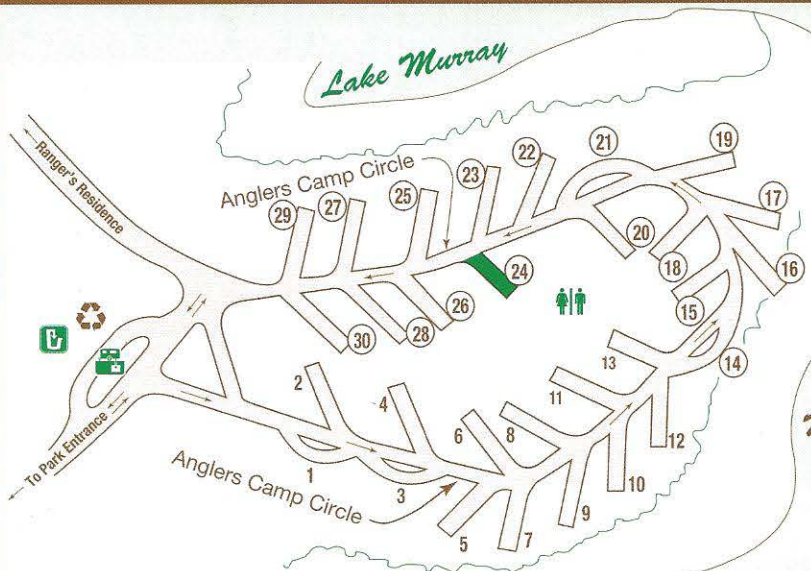

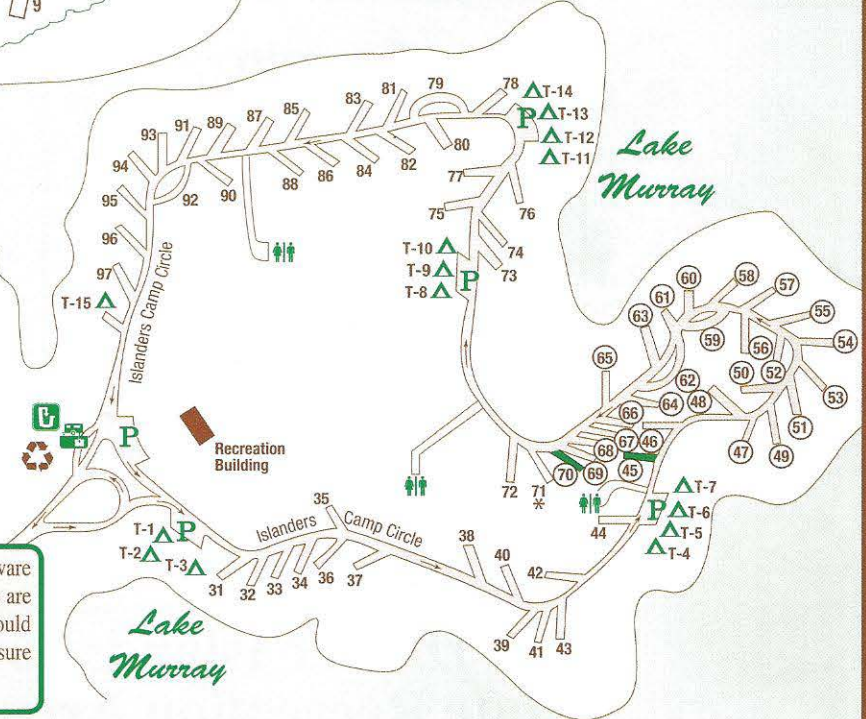

To ensure that your State Park experience is enjoyable, please be aware of the dynamic characteristics of the natural environment. There are some areas that may be potentially hazardous. All visitors should exercise caution when visiting any state park. Anyone who is unsure about possible hazards should contact a Park Ranger.



Campground Rules and Regulations

1. Campers are allowed a maximum of one trailer/RV and one tent OR two tents per site. No more than six (6) persons (or one family) may occupy the same site.
2. Some designated sites are limited to one tent.
3. Two sites designated for use by disabled persons are available at each park.
4. Camping check-in is 2 p.m.; **Check-out is 12 noon.**
5. Quiet hours are 10 p.m. - 7 a.m.
6. Maximum length-of-stay on a particular site during periods of high demand is 14 nights. Longer stays are allowed during periods of less demand.
7. Camping parties may not register for more than 42 nights of any 49 consecutive night period (no more than 28 nights out of 60 consecutive night period at parks located on US Army Corp. of Engineering Property).
8. **Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.**
9. **Pets must be on a leash** (not longer than six feet) or under physically restrictive control at all times. Owners will be asked to remove noisy or dangerous pets or pets that threaten or harass wildlife. **Pets not allowed in cabins or cabin areas.**
10. **It is unlawful to dispose of any waste (including gray water) in places or receptacles other than those specifically designed for that purpose.**
11. All fires must be confined to designated grills or areas.
12. It is unlawful to cut, damage or remove plants, shrubs or trees.
13. **Possession of firearms is prohibited** except by certified park rangers and other authorized personnel.
14. It is unlawful to possess or discharge fireworks or other explosives.
15. Only licensed vehicles may be operated in a state park and must remain in areas specifically intended for vehicular traffic. Golf carts must display a valid permit at all times.
16. Cancellations and changes are subject to fees based on the notice given. Changes are not permitted unless requested at least four days in advance for camping. Early departures are subject to cancellation policies. Transaction fees are non-refundable.
17. Registered campers may not change sites without permission from park staff.
18. **South Carolina senior citizens** (age 65 and older) and disabled residents may register for a campsite at a reduced rate. The qualifying individual must be present for the duration of the stay.
19. Visitors not registered for an overnight stay are required to pay the admission fee.
20. Roadside parking is prohibited. Do not park on unoccupied sites for any length of time.
