DO BRING:

Clothes:

Dress Considerations:

You are a role model for your campers. We ask that you dress in a manner that is appropriate for a job working with children and impressionable teens. Revealing clothing or clothing displaying offensive emblems, slogans or ads for products such as alcohol and tobacco are NOT considered appropriate. Shorts should be a reasonable length. All undergarments should be covered. For safety reasons, closed-toe shoes must be worn at all times except for trips to the bathhouse and pool.

CONSIDER BRINGING:

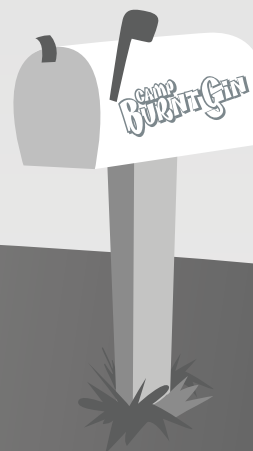
- Portable fan
