Steer calves 5.00-12.00 lower. Heifer calves 10.00-20.00 lower. Demand light to moderate as cattle futures made a sharp decline. Best demand for long weaned cattle and feeder cattle that would finish in April. Quality average to many attractive with several load lots of feeder cattle and long weaned calves available. Weather has warmed up to the upper 50's and low 60's since last weekend's ice storm. Supply included 56 percent over 600 lbs; and 32 percent heifers.										
Slaughter cows and bulls sold 5.00-10.00 lower. No recent comparison of slaughter bulls to test trends but a lower undertone is noted. Packer demand light. Demand very good for replacement cows. Total of 428 cows and bulls sold with 23 percent going to packers.
