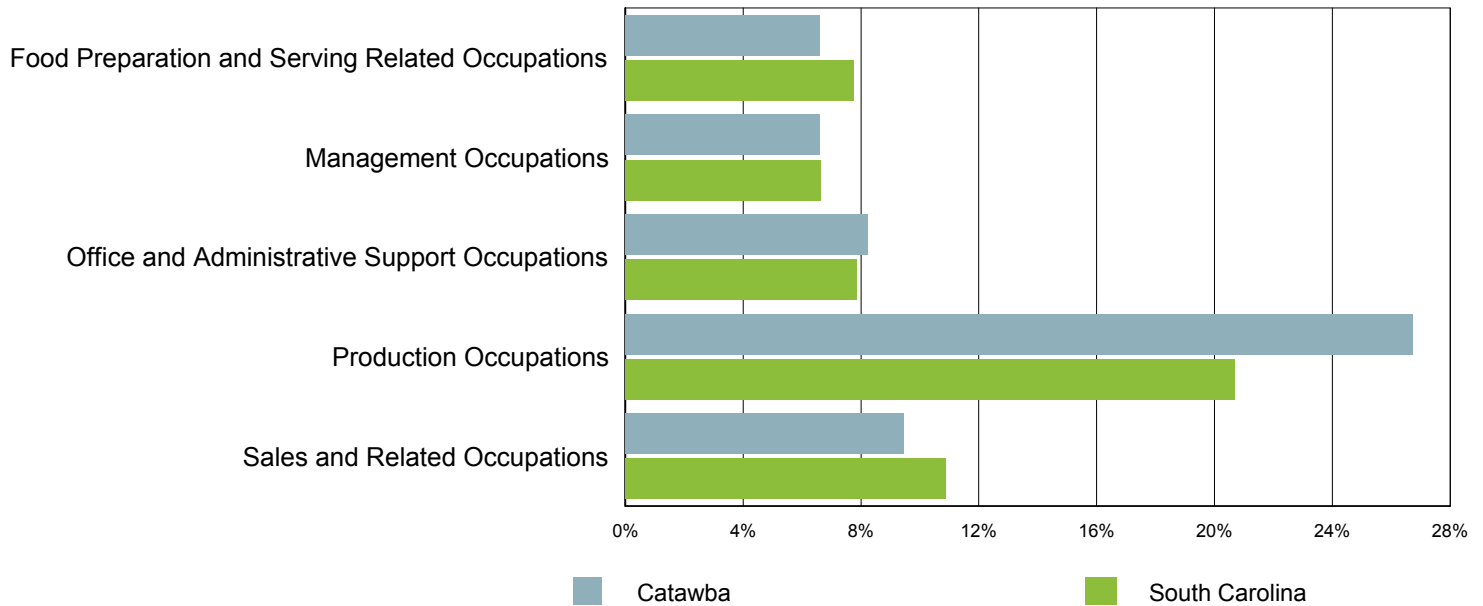

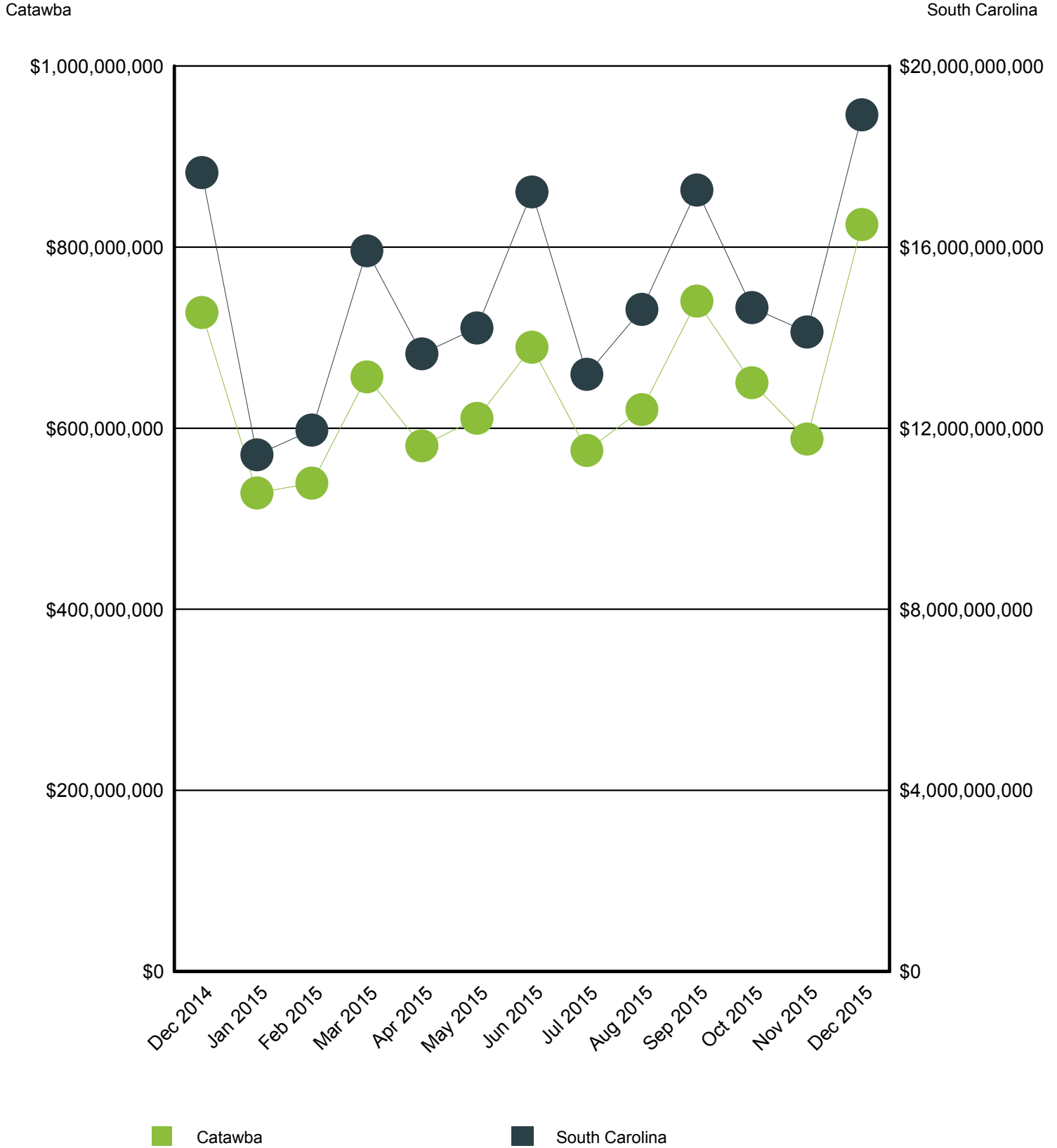

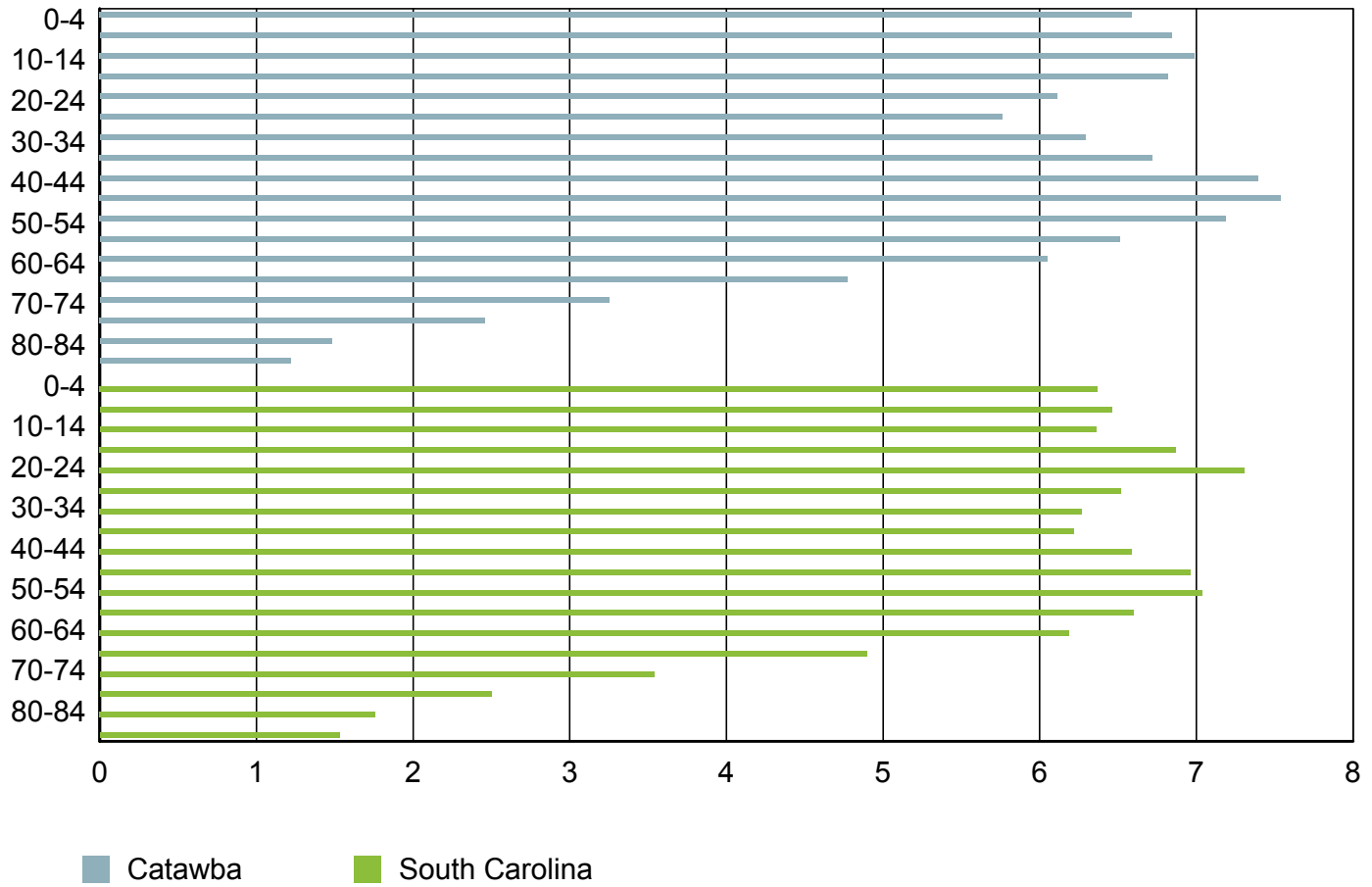


# Retail Sales

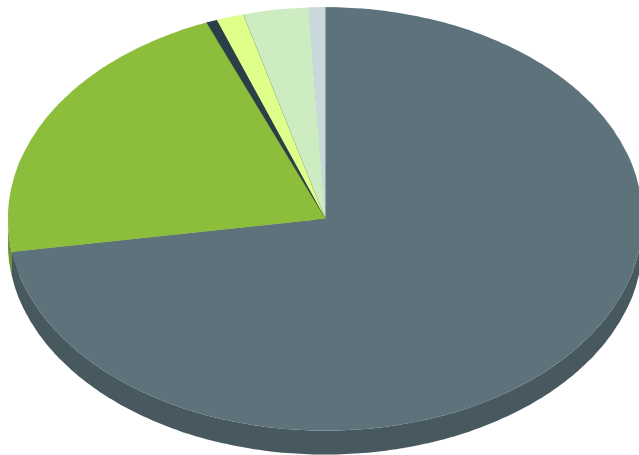

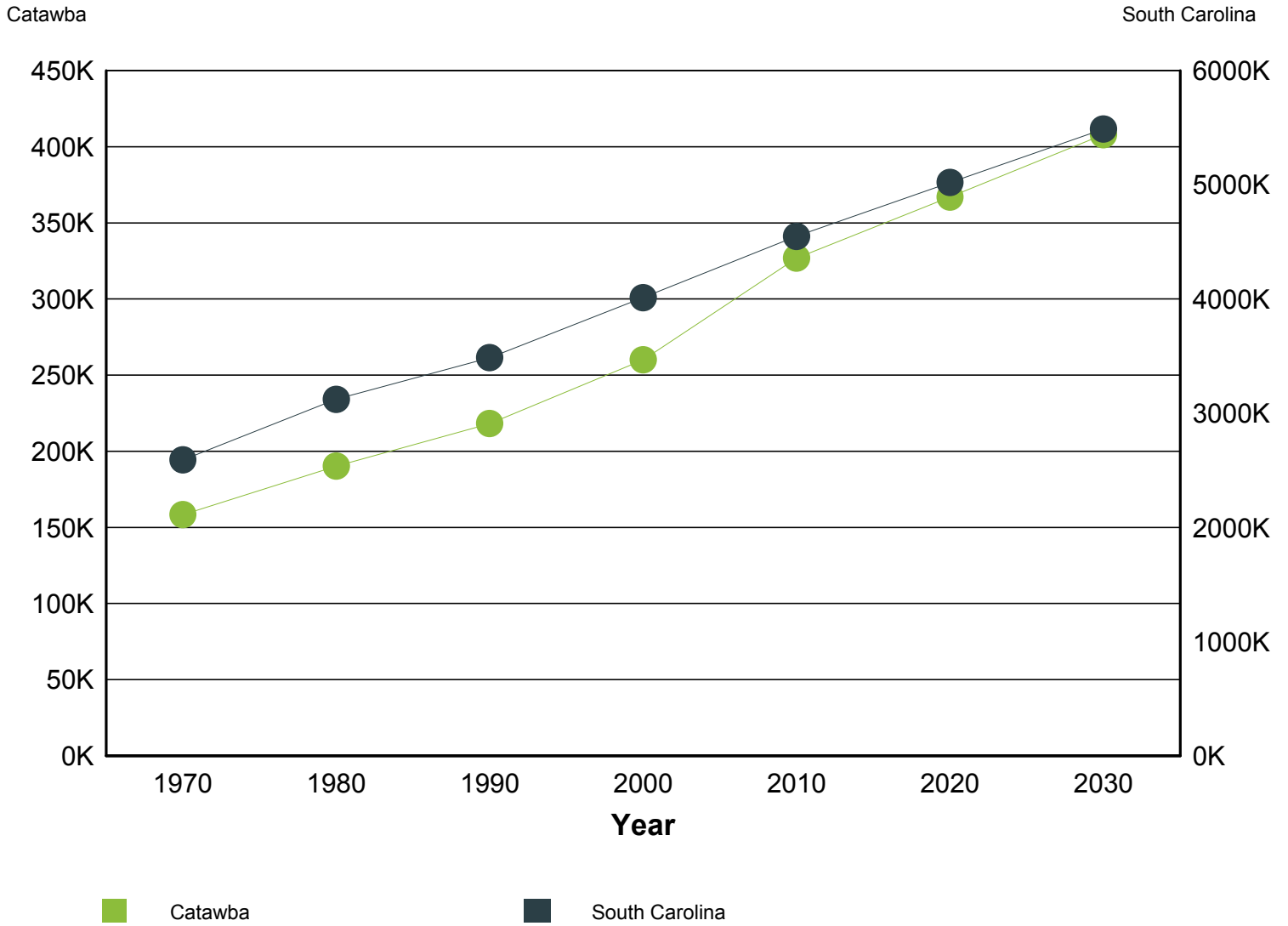

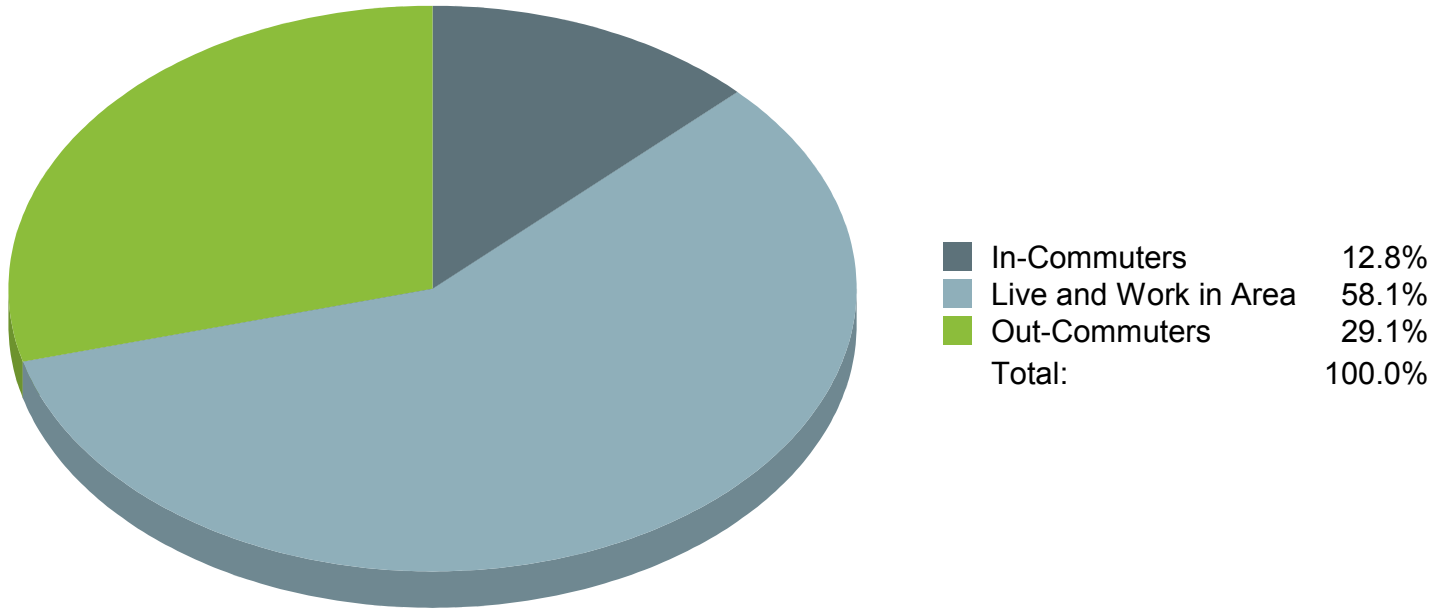

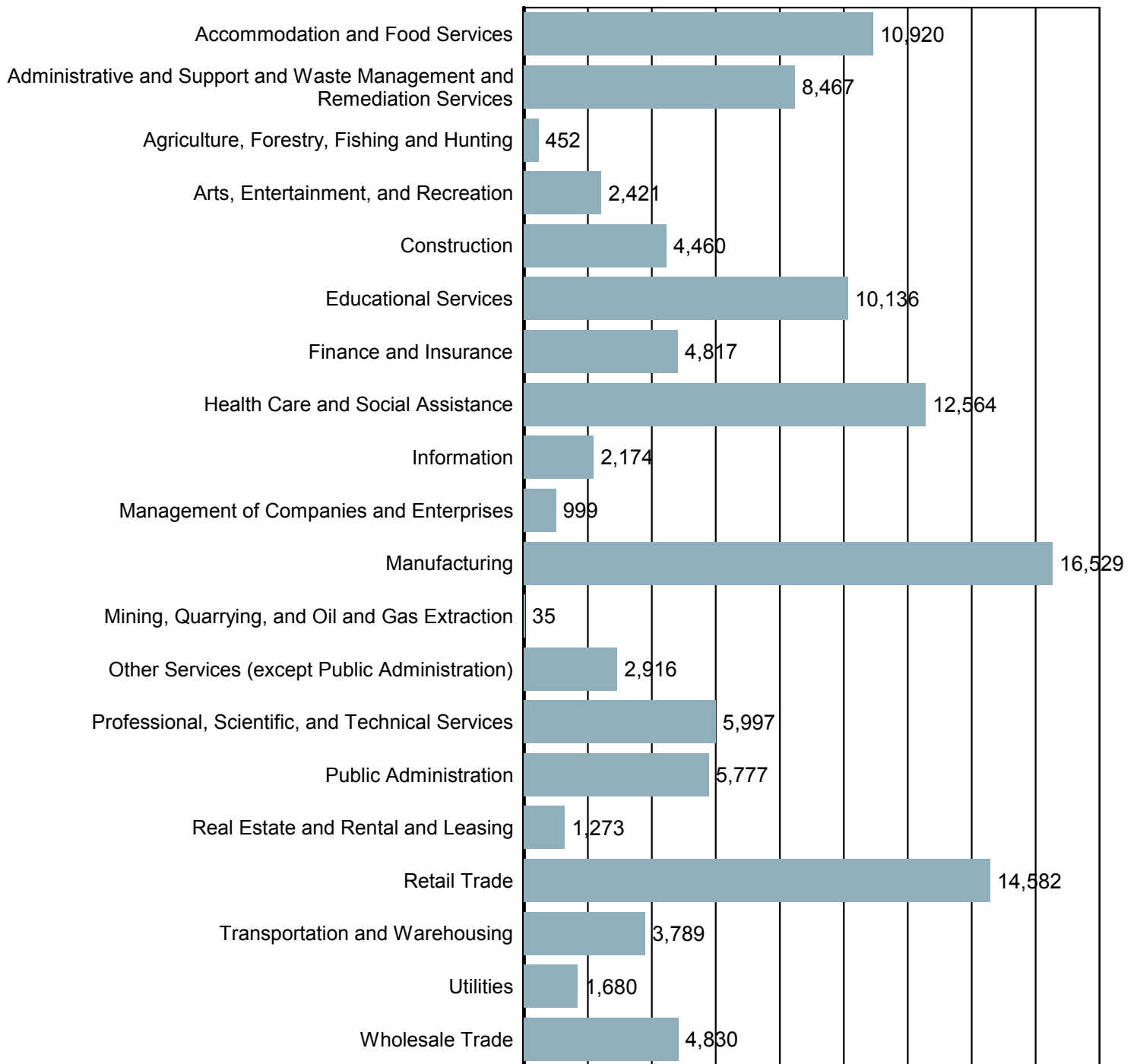

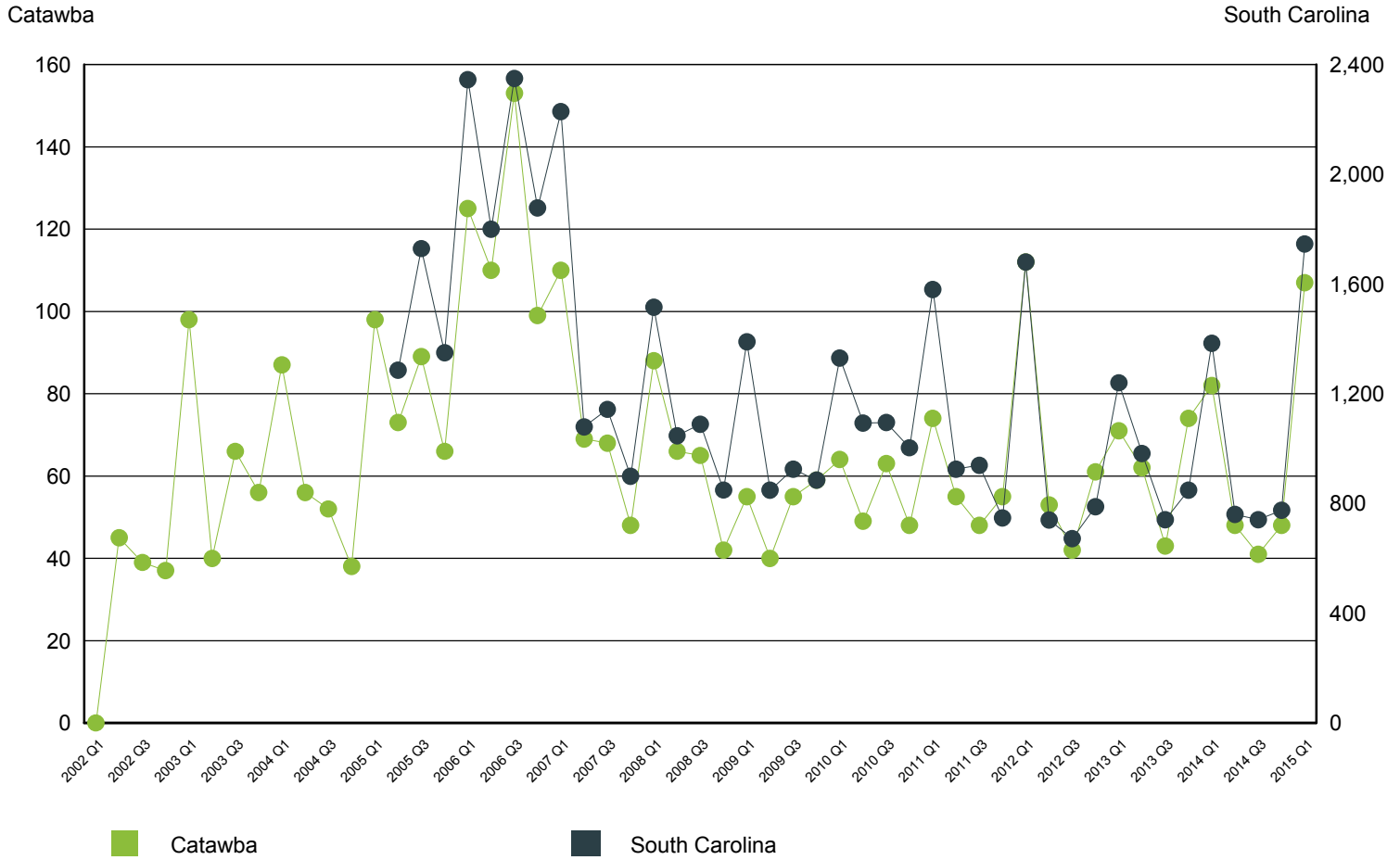


### Employment by Industry

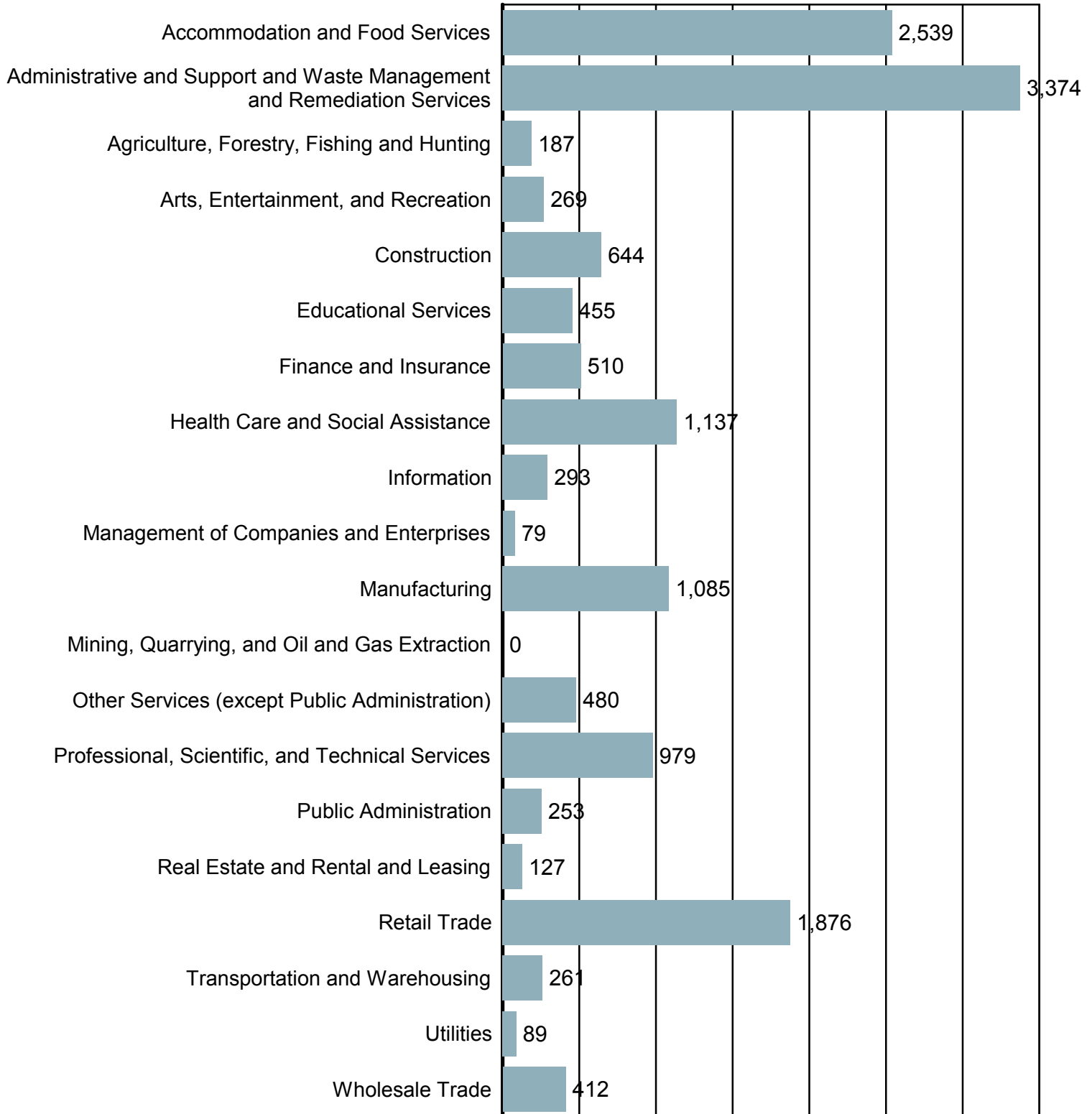

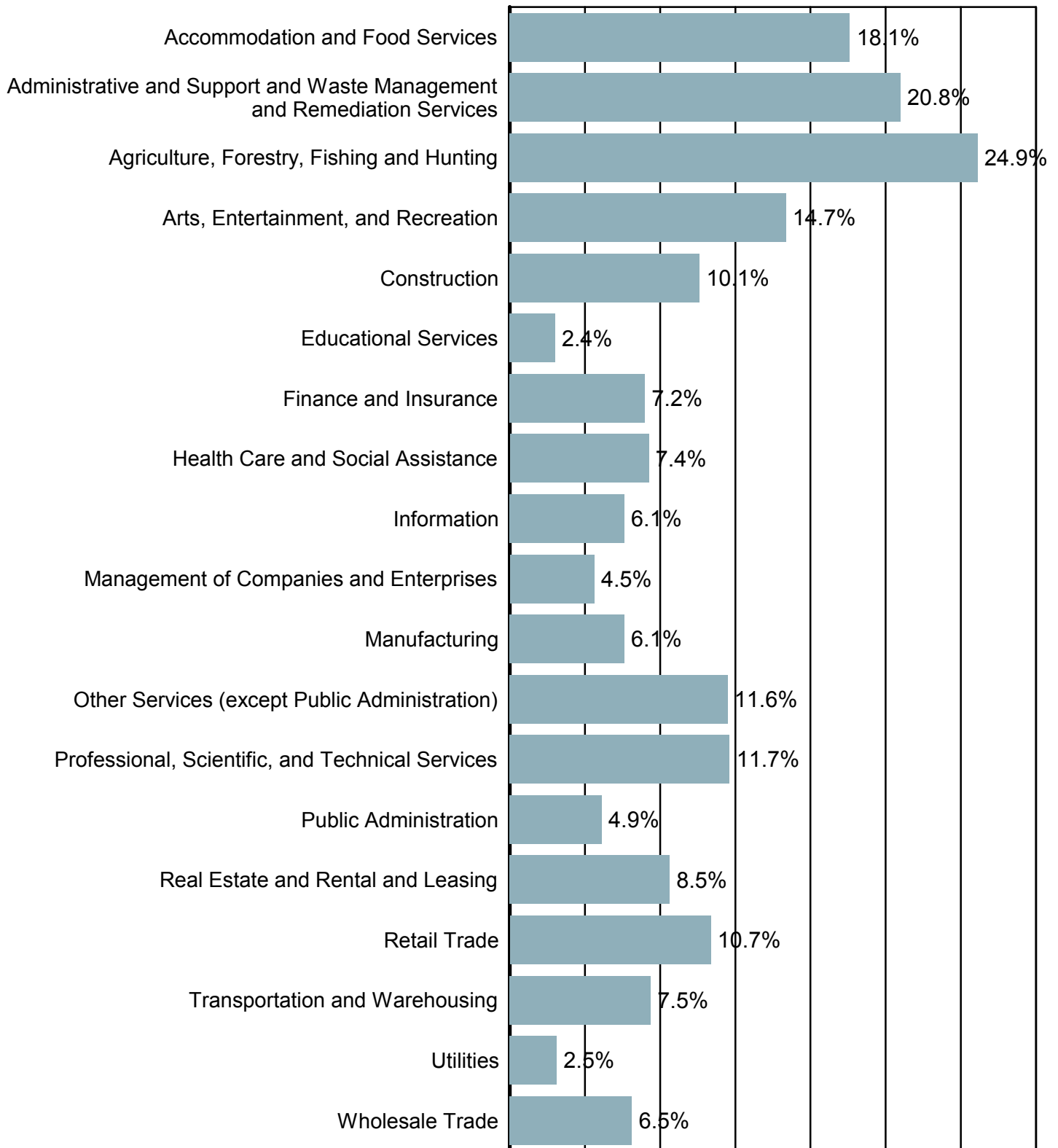

## New Hires by Industry



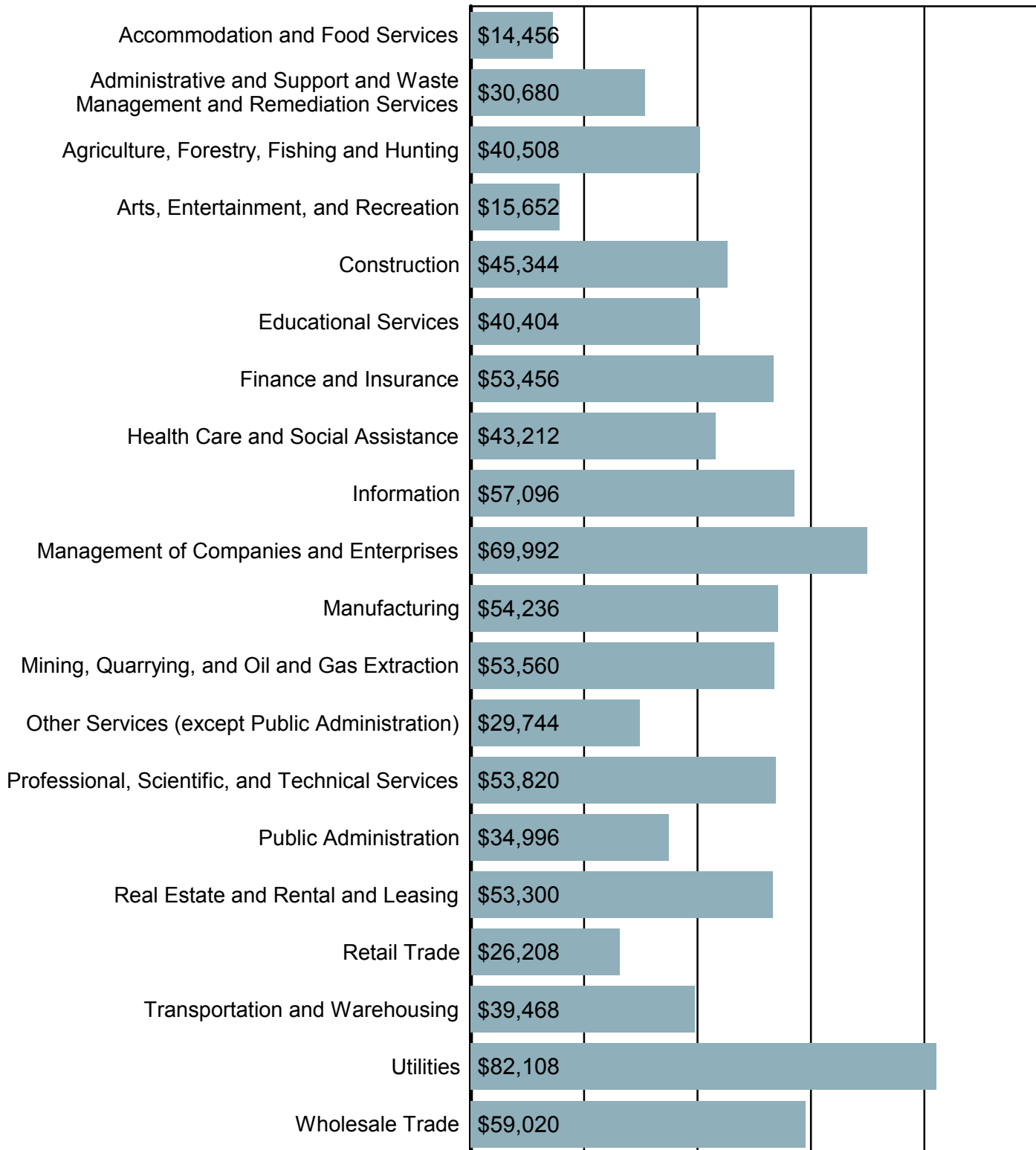

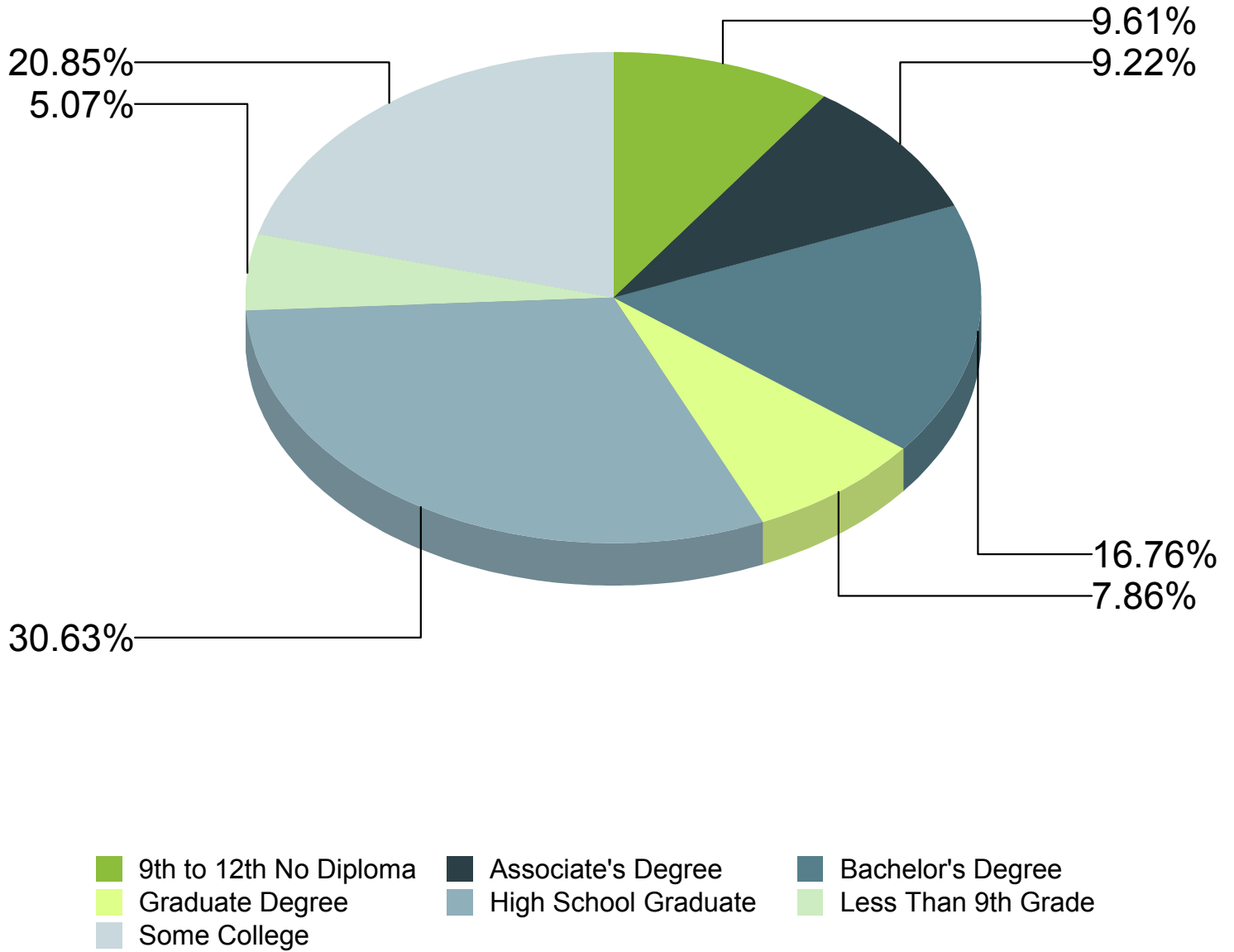

# Educational Attainment

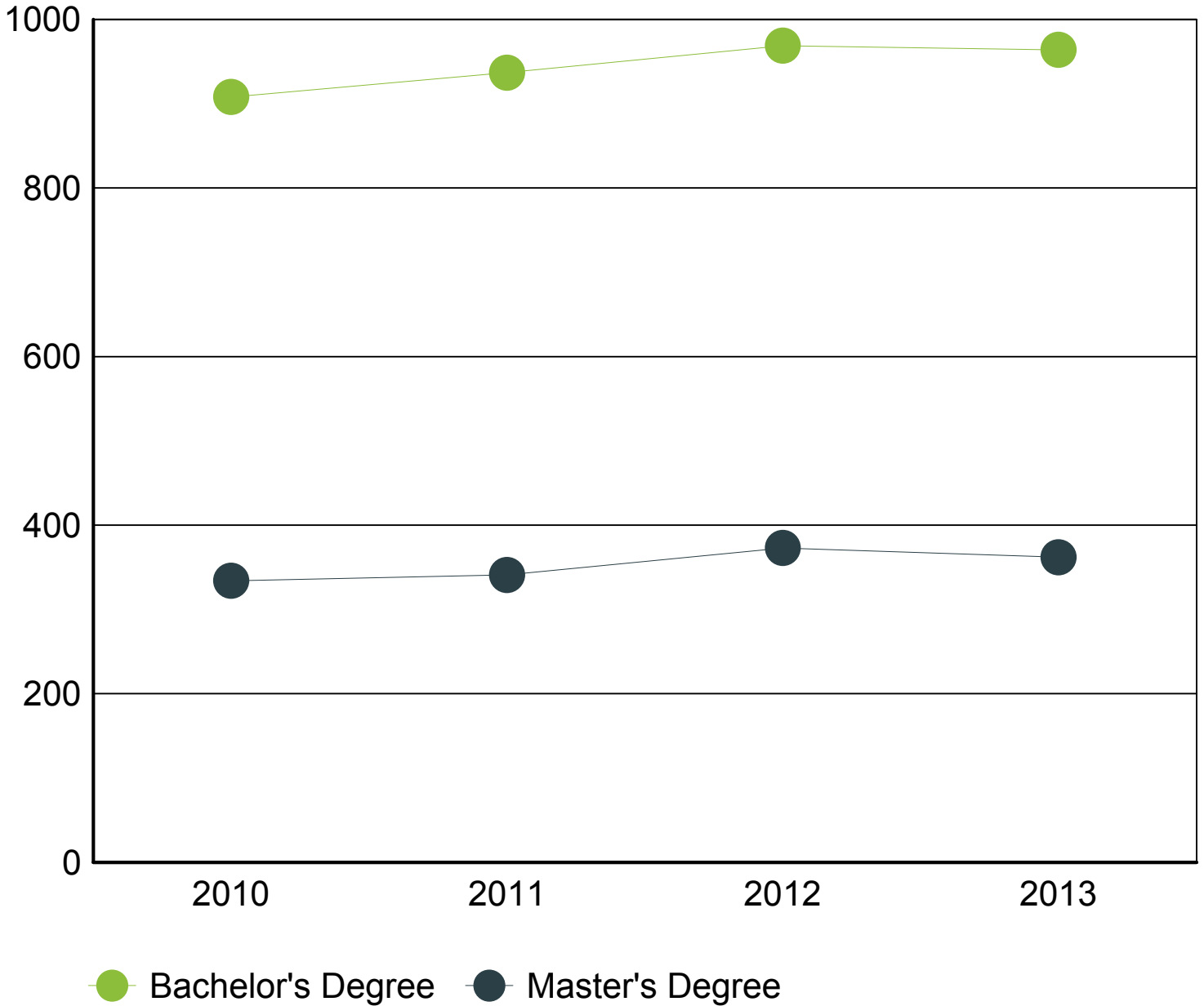
(Population 25 Years and Older)
