Compared to two weeks ago: Feeder steer and heifers traded mostly 1.00 to 5.00 higher, with 900-950 lb steers up to 9.00 higher. Steers and heifer calves mostly 2.00 to 8.00 higher on limited numbers, as the bulk of the supply weighed over 700 lbs. Quality was mostly average to attractive. The market was in line with the large advancements reported in the CME Feeder Cattle contract last week. Drier weather is finally in the forecast for June, as May closed out the wettest month in Oklahoma history. Supply included 79 percent over 600 lbs and 36 percent heifers. Slaughter cows 3.00-7.00 lower, Breaker cows up to 10.00 lower. Slaughter bulls 2.00-3.00 lower. Packer demand moderate at best. Beef movement remains very slow on heavy supplies after lackluster holiday beef sales. Demand remains very good for cows returning to the country.
