Demand good for all classes, especially cattle headed to grass pasture or graze out wheat. Most conditions of cattle improved from last week and thin fleshed to moderate flesh with gaunt to full weigh-ups. Rains fell over the weekend and temperatures are expected to be more spring like for the first of the week, though cooler temps and more rain are expected for the upcoming weekend.
