Lightweight calves lightly tested with a higher undertone noted. Demand good. Quality average with more than a few larger loads of attractive cattle. Trade active with a big crowd on hand for most of the day. A handful of new crop calves right off the cow on offer as well. Feeder cattle supply included 59 percent Steers, 40 percent Heifers, and 2 percent Bulls. Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 82 percent.							
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows steady to 2.00 lower. Slaughter bulls sold steady. Packer demand light to moderate. Hot dry weather beginning to take it's toll with several thin fleshed cows of all ages included in supply. A total of 436 cows and bulls sold with 43 percent going to packers.
