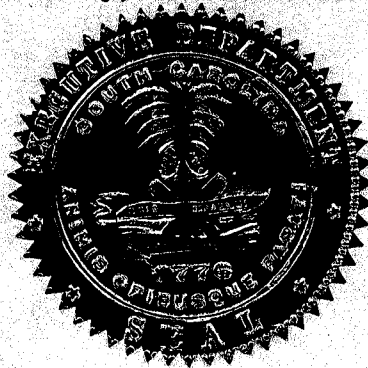
EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, administrative proceedings are now pending in the Probate Court for Marion County in respect to the estate of James B. Dixon, deceased, and,




