WHEREAS, automotive service professionals are highly trained in the technical and diagnostic skills used to maintain, service, and repair motor vehicles; and

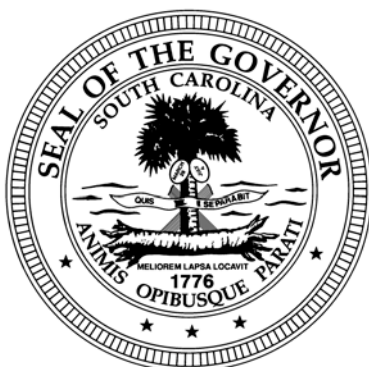
WHEREAS, over one million automotive service professionals throughout the country ensure that our cars and trucks travel safely over the nation's roadways; and
