## Governor's Proclamation

**WHEREAS,** the right of American citizens to vote is ensured by the United States Constitution, and registering empowers us to vote on Election Day, upholding the basis of democracy with one voice, one vote; and

**WHEREAS,** while over 2 million South Carolinians are currently registered to vote, an additional 830,000 people are eligible but have not yet registered; and

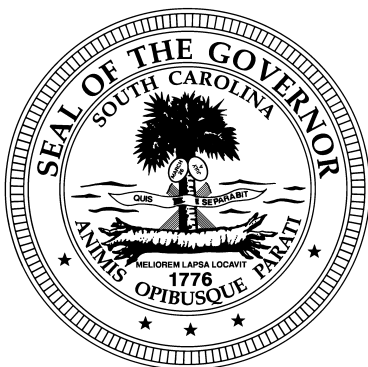
**WHEREAS,** the voter registration process is easy and convenient, with applications available at county voter registration offices, the Department of Motor Vehicles and other state agencies, on-line and at various locations across the Palmetto State during voter registration drives; and

**WHEREAS,** November 2, 2004, is Election Day across South Carolina and the nation, with people casting their votes for President, members of Congress, state and local officials, amendments to our state's Constitution and local issues.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I,** Mark Sanford, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim September 2004 as

throughout the state and encourage all eligible South Carolinians to register and exercise their right to vote.
