FOR
AIR ENTRAINING AND CHEMICAL ADMIXTURES FOR CONCRETE
QUALIFIED PRODUCT LISTING 5

All producers who wish to be included on QPL 5 must complete a product testing by the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) National Transportation Product Evaluation Program (NTPEP). Once NTPEP/AMRL testing has been completed and NTPEP has published the report, submit a letter with the NTPEP code (CADDxxxxxx) and date of the testing to the Structural Materials Engineer.

All air entraining admixtures shall comply with AASHTO M 154 and accelerated retarding and water reducing admixtures shall comply with AASHTO M 194.

The test results will be reviewed and if the specifications are met, the product will be listed on QPL 5.

For any minor/major changes in the product, the product must be re-tested and evaluated by NTPEP.

NTPEP testing is required at least every five (5) years.

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
