Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 75%.									
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows sold steady to 2.00 lower and slaughter bulls mostly 4.00 lower after last week's high quality on offer. Demand moderate to good. A total of 431 cows and bulls sold with 60 percent going to packers.
