Hot Applied Preformed Thermoplastic Pavement Markings

Only materials from sources appearing on the Department's approval list, titled "Hot Applied Preformed Thermoplastic Pavement Markings," as of the project's bid date shall be used for that project. A manufacturer may request approval by furnishing the following information to the Research and Materials Engineer to verify that the marking meets the requirements of the specification titled "Hot Applied Preformed Thermoplastic Pavement Markings" dated July 30, 1998.

- (1) Appropriate information and satisfactory test results verifying the product has been tested or is currently being tested by the National Transportation Product Evaluation Program (NTPEP). If the product has been tested by NTPEP, include the appropriate sample numbers to indicate which test results apply.
- (2) A certified affidavit with test results from a recognized laboratory verifying that the material meets the requirements of this specification.
- (3) Complete instructions for installing the material.
- (4) Complete identification of each type of material along with brand name and stock numbers to be used when purchasing.
- (5) Materials safety data sheet for the product furnished.
- (6) A notarized statement for each product to be approved stating the product meets all SCDOT specifications and that the manufacturer complies with the warranty terms of this specification.

Withdrawal of Approval: The Department reserves the right to remove any material from the approval listing if, in the opinion of the Research and Materials Engineer, the product is not performing satisfactorily under field conditions.
