The South Carolina Department of Transportation publishes Hydraulic Design bulletins to be used in conjunction with the Requirements for Hydraulic Design Studies publication, which details the studies required by the Department for the hydraulic design of bridges, roadway drainage, outfalls, and the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System studies.
