Fiscal Impact Summary

The fiscal impact of this bill on the Department of Transportation (DOT) and local governments is pending, contingent upon responses from the agencies.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on February 5, 2020

State Expenditure

This bill allows an owner of an outdoor advertising sign to relocate or adjust the sign if it is obstructed by the construction of a sound barrier. The cost of relocation must be borne by the entity responsible for the construction of the sound barrier. In addition, DOT must pay just compensation for the removal of a sign that has been obstructed by the construction of a sound barrier within the highway right-of-way. The expenditure impact of the bill on DOT is pending, contingent upon a response from the agency.

This bill requires a local government that has been issued an encroachment permit from DOT for the construction of a sound barrier within a highway right-of-way to provide compensation to the owner of the outdoor advertising sign.
