Heifer calves were too lightly tested for an accurate trend but a lower undertone noted. Demand light to moderate. CME Live Cattle Futures closed lower again Monday limit down for the front month, however Feeder Cattle contracts closed all positive. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (65% Steers, 33% Heifers, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 81%.										
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows mostly 6.00-11.00 lower. Slaughter bulls 5.00-7.00 lower on a very light test. Packer demand light. A total of 137 cows and bulls sold with 69 percent going to packers. The estimated dressed cost at the Oklahoma National Stockyards: Lean cows 103.20; Boners 106.30; Breakers 102.50; Light weight 101.50; Bulls 137.70. Supply included: 70% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 28% Slaughter Cattle (90% Cows, 10% Bulls) 1% Replacement Cattle (100% Bred Cows). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
