WHEREAS, the more than 7,000 registered engineers in South Carolina are dedicated to enriching our state through their work in construction, education, government, industry, and private practice; and

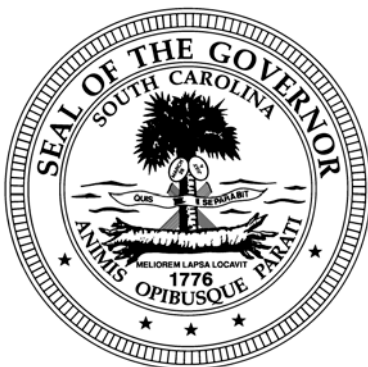
