WHEREAS, landscape architects are dedicated to promoting the careful stewardship, planning, and artful design of our cultural and natural environments; and

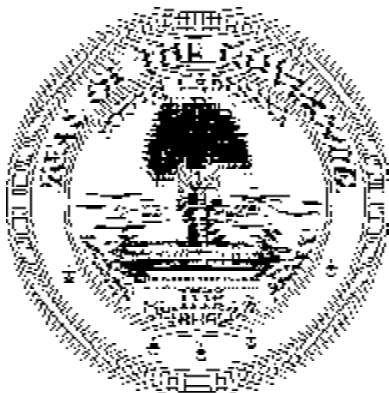
