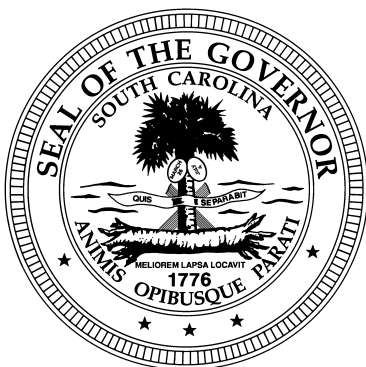
Governor's Proclamation
