Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers 5.00-8.00 lower. Steer and heifer calves 2.00-5.00 lower. Demand moderate. Much needed moisture fell over the trade area this past week bringing cooler temperatures. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (55% Steers, 44% Heifers, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 66%.

Compared to last week: Slaughter cows steady to 2.00 higher. Slaughter bulls 1.00-2.00 higher. Several high quality bulls offered. A total of 231 cows and bulls sold with 74% going to packers. Supply included: 69% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 23% Slaughter Cattle (79% Cows, 21% Bulls); 8% Replacement Cattle (80% Bred Cows, 20% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
