**Oklahoma National Stockyards Weekly Cattle Summary**

Compared to last week: Feeder steers steady to 3.00 lower. Feeder heifers 4.00-6.00 lower. Steer and heifer calves lightly tested and few sales 6.00-9.00 lower. Demand moderate, despite much higher corn prices. Quality average to mostly attractive. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (55% Steers, 44% Heifers, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 76%.

Compared to last week: Slaughter cows 2.00 lower. Slaughter bulls steady. Limited numbers of bred cows and pairs available. A total of 368 cows and bulls sold with 48% going to packers. Supply included: 46% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 26% Slaughter Cattle (89% Cows, 11% Bulls); 28% Replacement Cattle (73% Bred Cows, 27% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
