WHEREAS, pollination plays a vital role in the health of our national forests and grasslands, which provide forage, fish and wildlife, timber, water, mineral resources, and recreational opportunities as well as enhanced economic development opportunities for communities across our state and nation; and

WHEREAS, pollinator species provide significant environmental benefits that are necessary for maintaining healthy, biodiverse ecosystems; and

WHEREAS, the maintenance of healthy pollinator populations is critical to the continued economic well-being of agricultural producers.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mark Sanford, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim June 24 - 30, 2007, as

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to join in celebrating the vital significance of pollinators to agriculture and to public lands.
