WHEREAS, Health Occupations Students of America (HOSA) is a national career and technical organization for students preparing for careers in health care; and

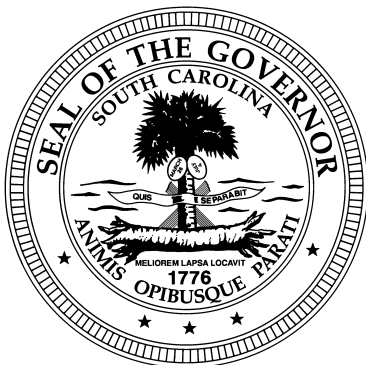
