Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, sixty years ago, WRHI Radio signed on the air for the first time, becoming the ninth radio station in South Carolina and one of the first 600 in the nation; and

WHEREAS, born of a belief in local broadcasting and a dream of community service, WRHI News-Talk 1340 is a pioneer in radio broadcasting that continues its original mission to represent the people of the Rock Hill area; and

WHEREAS, originating in Lancaster in 1964, WRHM-FM, "The Best Country Around," has expanded its operations to cover fifteen counties across the Carolinas; and

WHEREAS, together, sister stations WRHI and WRHM-FM have contributed 100 years of quality radio programming to the residents of our state.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mark Sanford, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim December 14, 2004, as

WRHI-AM AND WRHM-FM RADIO 100 YEARS OF BROADCASTING EXCELLENCE DAY

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to recognize the positive contributions of WRHI and WRHM-FM to radio broadcasting excellence in the Palmetto State.
