**WHEREAS,** Family Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) is a national career and technology organization for family and consumer sciences students; and

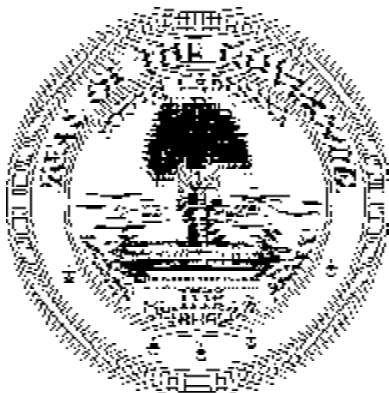
**WHEREAS,** FCCLA is dedicated to providing these students with practical education in the areas of personal growth, family life, career and technology preparation, and community involvement; and
