WHEREAS, the coastal areas of the Palmetto State are host to millions of visitors each year who contribute significantly to our local and state economies; and

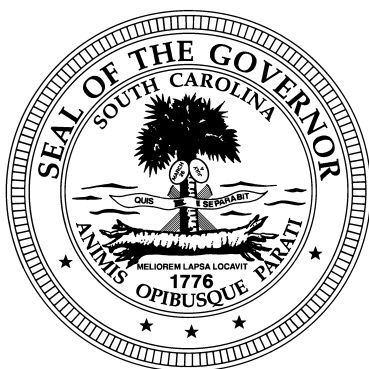
WHEREAS, coastal tourism and healthy seafood help sustain our communities, providing jobs and revenue for our state; and
