WHEREAS, many volunteers in the Palmetto State direct their efforts towards our youth, donating their time, energy, and talents to help our young people succeed; and

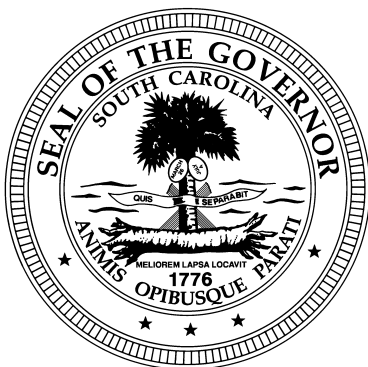
