WHEREAS, graduation from high school or college is a major accomplishment, particularly for young people in foster care whose lives are often filled with instability and impermanence; and

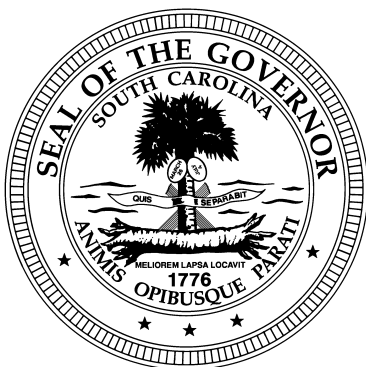
WHEREAS, through their perseverance, dedication, and hard work, the young people in foster care who have reached this significant milestone have helped secure a brighter future for themselves; and
