Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers steady to 2.00 higher. Steer and heifer calves unevenly steady, not all weights well tested. Demand moderate to good. Quality average. Some much needed rain is moving across the state and more is expected as the week goes on. Another good week of slaughter cattle movement last week as prices held steady. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (53% Steers, 45% Heifers, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 65%.											
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows 8.00-10.00 lower and bulls 3.00-6.00 lower. Demand moderate to good. Quality average. Several Bred Cows offered. Some moisture is predicted for most of the region during the middle of the week. A total of 672 cows and bulls sold with 65 percent going to packers. Supply included: 40% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 44% Slaughter Cattle (96% Cows, 4% Bulls); 17% Replacement Cattle (28% Bred Cows, 72% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
