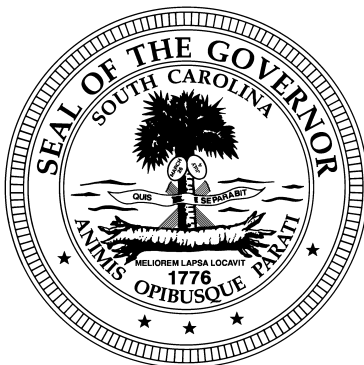
WHEREAS, payroll professionals are dedicated to educating the business community and the public at large about the payroll tax withholding systems and improving compliance with government procedures; and
