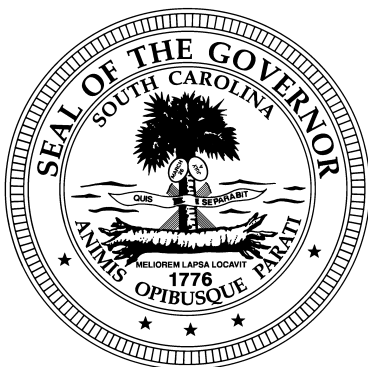
WHEREAS, students involved in the arts are more likely to develop a deep understanding of multi-cultural values and beliefs; and
