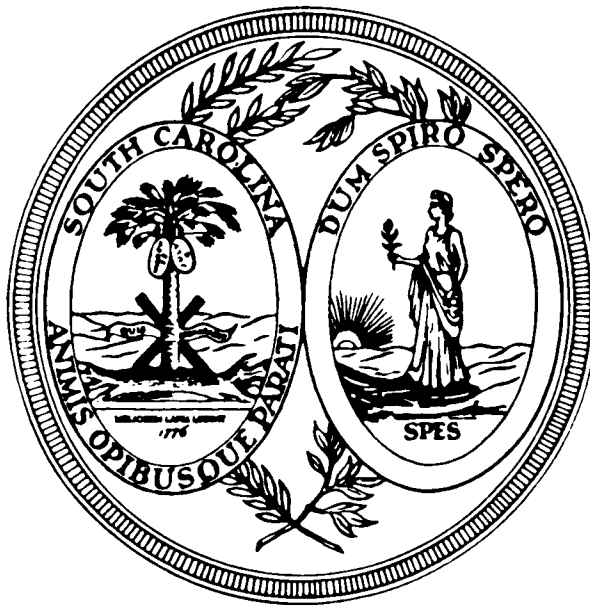

### 1986 TOBACCO YEAR IN REVIEW

South Carolina tobacco growers sold 72,831,250 pounds for \$104,219,230.38, averaging \$143.10 per 100 pounds on the 1986 flue-cured market. Sales for dealers and resales for warehousemen made total sales amount to 81,543,395 pounds for \$116,801,111.92.

In 1985, South Carolina producers totaled sales of 92,596,909 pounds for cash receipts of \$159,884,921.37 for an average per 100 pounds of \$172.67. Additional sales by dealers and resales for warehousemen accounted for 1985 total sales on South Carolina markets of 102,476,010 pounds for \$176,802,008.33.

Markets opened August 5 and closed October 16 with 41 sales days, according to the Tobacco Market News Service of the Tobacco Division of the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Agricultural Marketing Service.

The Tobacco Market News Service reported grade averages were lower due to reduced support prices. The grower assessment was only two and one half cents per pounds compared to 25 cents in 1985.

All grade averages were down with the top sales price of \$180 per 100 pounds compared with the \$196 posted in 1985. Less desirable tobacco was on the warehouse floors for the 1986 season due to an increase in low, poor and nondescript offerings with less good and fair quality.

Weather conditions beyond the control of the growers plagued the 1986 tobacco crop in South Carolina from the planting of seed beds in early February throughout the harvest in late July and early August.

These conditions went from one extreme to the other. There was too little rain in most areas and even too much rain in one coastal county. Frost hit the tender tobacco plants in early April and hail battered the mature plants later during the growing season. A knockout blow was delivered by a string of 15 straight days when the temperature topped 100 degrees in the Pee Dee area in mid-summer.

South Carolina tobacco growers produced this 1986 crop under most difficult circumstances and South Carolina tobacco warehousemen are to be commended for marketing the crop to end a most unusual year.

Flue-cured Stabilization receipts for the season amounted to 8.4 percent of the net sales compared with 18.8 percent of net sales placed under loan for the 1985 crop.
