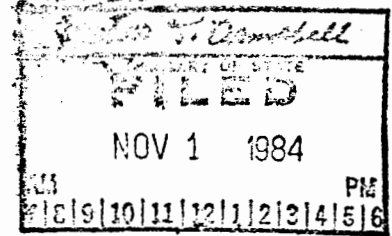
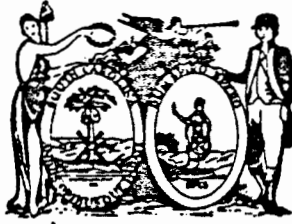

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 84-34
