## OVERVIEW

Working in close collaboration with the City of Charleston, the South Carolina State Ports Authority is creating a plan for its Union Pier Cruise Terminal and the surrounding area.

The planning team is led by Cooper, Robertson & Partners, one of the nation's preeminent planning and design firms. The planning process will include continuous opportunities for public input.

## GOALS

- Create a financially viable plan for a new cruise terminal that is attractive and in keeping with the character of historic Charleston
- Comply with today's enhanced cruise security requirements
- Mitigate impacts on existing infrastructure and traffic
- Identify additional uses for the Union Pier property that bring enjoyment to Charlestonians and enhance the local economy
- Increase public access to Charleston's historic waterfront

## PLANNING PROCESS

The planning process is expected to take about four months and include four phases:

### PHASE I

Discovery and Analysis, during which the planning team will study the site and related economic, design, and engineering data.

### PHASE II

Listening and Planning, including a public 'listening session' currently scheduled for October 28th.

### PHASE III

Preliminary Plan, developed and presented to the public for comments and input, currently planned for mid-December.

### PHASE IV

Union Pier Cruise Terminal Plan, to be presented to the public, currently planned for late January.
