WHEREAS, a cancer survivor is anyone living with a history of cancer from the moment of diagnosis through the remainder of life; and

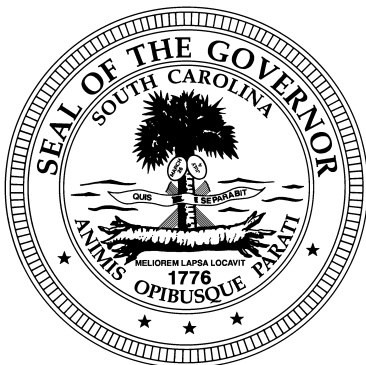
WHEREAS, each year, communities around the globe hold events to recognize cancer survivors and to show that life after cancer diagnosis can be a reality, and
