Acknowledgement and Assurances

Clemson University acknowledges that the institution received funding under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 (CRRSAA). Section 314(d)(5) of CRRSAA requires the institution to provide at least the same amount of funding in financial aid grants to students as was required to be provided under section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act. The institution has distributed, or intends to distribute, no less than \$6,789,998 in emergency financial aid grants to eligible students.

Methodology for Emergency Financial Aid Grants Under Section 314(a)(1) of CRRSAA:

Clemson University’s Plan for Emergency Aid Distribution (Approved):

- Prioritize awards to students with the greatest need as encouraged by the Secretary of Education.
- Award \$1,000 to each Pell Grant Recipient currently enrolled.
- Award \$750 to each student with an Expected Family Contribution of less than \$10,000.
- Award \$500 to each student with any gross financial need as demonstrated by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- An award notice sent to each student will explain the purpose of the CRRSAA funds awarded to them.
- Awards will be made to students via Financial Aid’s awarding process. All disbursements will be refunded directly to the student via direct deposit or paper check, depending on the student’s method of payment in the student system.
