1989 TOBACCO YEAR IN REVIEW

Variety dominated the 1989 tobacco season in South Carolina, in both production and marketing. Along with the wide range of weather conditions, there was a variation in prices paid for the crop.

Producers sold 98,773,862 pounds of tobacco for \$164,140,217.92 for an average of \$166.18 per 100 pounds. These totals reflected an increase from the 1988 season when producers sold 91,826,112 pounds for \$148,039,839.56, showing an average per 100 pounds of \$161.22.

Growers faced an unusual array of weather conditions, beginning with a wet March which slowed land preparation and cool temperatures which held back plant growth. Transplanting from the beds to the field for the crop took place from late March through mid-April on to late May due to the wet field conditions. Showers in late May and early June along with hot weather caused a growing spurt for the crop which resulted in pre-mature flowering and increased disease problems.

Harvesting began the last week in June and reached a mid-July peak. During this time, rainfall ranged from an ample amount to dryness in other areas. During August, some areas reported excessive amounts of moisture, too. Extreme rain and hot weather this month resulted in a rapidly maturing of the late planted tobacco.

The South Carolina tobacco crop became a victim of Hurricane Hugo Sept. 21-22 with extensive damage to tobacco both in the field and in packing houses and warehouses. Tobacco warehouses in Lake City, Hemingway, Kingstree and Timmonsville suffered heavy damage and roofs were blown off several facilities.

The Tobacco Market News of the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Agricultural Marketing Service noted of the season: "Demand was strong during the first week of auctions with grade averages improved in practically all cases. Volume was heavy and less than one percent of sales was placed under loan during the opening week."

For the second week, grade prices were higher and quality was improved. Strong demand continued through the fourth week while grade prices rose during the fifth, sixth and seventh weeks of sales. The decline began in the eighth week and continued for the remainder of the sales season.

The Tobacco Market News Service reported for the season: "Grade averages improved, but quality changed very little. There was a slight improvement in maturity. Ten percent of the offerings graded good quality; 54 percent fair; 27 percent low; three percent poor quality and no grade, wet and scrap tobacco, accounted for six percent. From a color standpoint, 57 percent

was classed as mature to mellow and 36 percent unripe or immature. Flue-Cured Stabilization receipts for the season amounted to 8,697,000 pounds or 4.7 percent of net sales, compared with 1988 when 1.7 percent of sales were placed under loan.

"Markets opened Aug. 7 and closed Oct. 26 with 46 sales days, one less than in 1988. Thirteen sets of buyers operated on the markets through Oct. 23, with a reduction in sets as markets closed."
