Criminal Background Check for Initial Massage Therapy License

Effective January 1, 2024, all applicants applying for a massage therapy license with the SC Board of Massage Therapy will be subject to a state and national fingerprint criminal background check. The fingerprint criminal background checks are required pursuant to § 40-30-110 of the SC Massage Therapy Practice Act.

In addition to other requirements established by law and to determine an applicant's eligibility for initial licensure as a massage therapist, state law also requires a state criminal records check by the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division and a national criminal records check.
