EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, it appears that there no longer exists within a five mile radius of the city limits of Columbia wide-spread acts of violence and threats of violence, common disregard for the law and disorders of a general nature which constitute a danger to the persons and property of the citizens of the community and threaten the peace and tranquility of the State;

NOW, THEREFORE, as of 12 Noon, April 15, 1968, I do hereby rescind the Executive Orders issued by Lieutenant Governor, John C. West, on April 9, 1968, and April 11, 1968, and declare them no longer of force and effect.
