WHEREAS, professional sports help develop and improve mental alertness, enthusiasm, and self-esteem while fostering active and constructive leisure habits; and

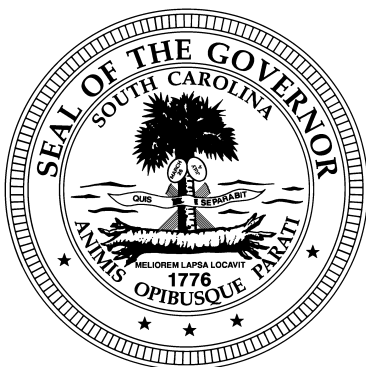
