1. + Indiantown Presbyterian Cemetery, 18 miles from Kingstree on Hemingway Highway.
2. x McClary Burying Ground, 5 miles South East of Kingstree on County road to Warsaw.
3. y Bethesda Methodist Churchyard, 4 miles East of Cades, S. C. on County road from Cades, to Indiantown, S. C.
4. x Old Bethany Baptist Churchyard about 2 miles South of Hemingway on S. C. Highway 511.
5. x Poplar Hill Free Will Baptist Cemetery, 4 miles South of Hemingway on S. C. Highway 511.
6. x Old Black Mingo Pres. Cemetery, 8 miles East of Nesmith, S. C. on Highway leading to Georgetown.
7. x Brittons Burying Ground, about 9 miles east of Nesmith, S. C. on Highway 511.
8. y The Baptist Black Mingo Churchyard, A. D. 1843. /Old Belin/ 7 Miles East of Nesmith, S. C. on County road.
9. x Grenoch Cemetery, 1 mile East of Gourdin, S. C. on County road leading to Sutton, S. C.
10. + McDonald Burying Ground, 3 miles East of Gourdin, S. C. near E. S. Shirer's Store.
11. - Witherspoon Burying Ground. 8½ miles South of Kingstree on Highway leading from Kingstree S. C. to Lane, S. C.
12. + Frierson Burying Ground, 2½ miles East of Salters on country road leading to Highway.
13. - Midway Presbyterian Churchyard, 16 miles from Kingstree, S. C. on Highway 175.
14. - Union Presbyterian Churchyard, 8 miles South Kingstree, S. C. on Highway leading to Lane, S. C.
15. - Sutton Methodist Churchyard, 9 Miles East of Gourdin, S. C. on County road leading to Sutton and Andrews, S. C.
16. - Kingstree Baptist Cemetery, Kingstree, S. C.
17. + New Market Cemetery, 3½ miles South of Greeleyville on Charleston Manning Highway.
18. y Richburg Burying Ground, 3.3 miles from Greeleyville, S. C. on Tyson road off of Old Manning Highway.
