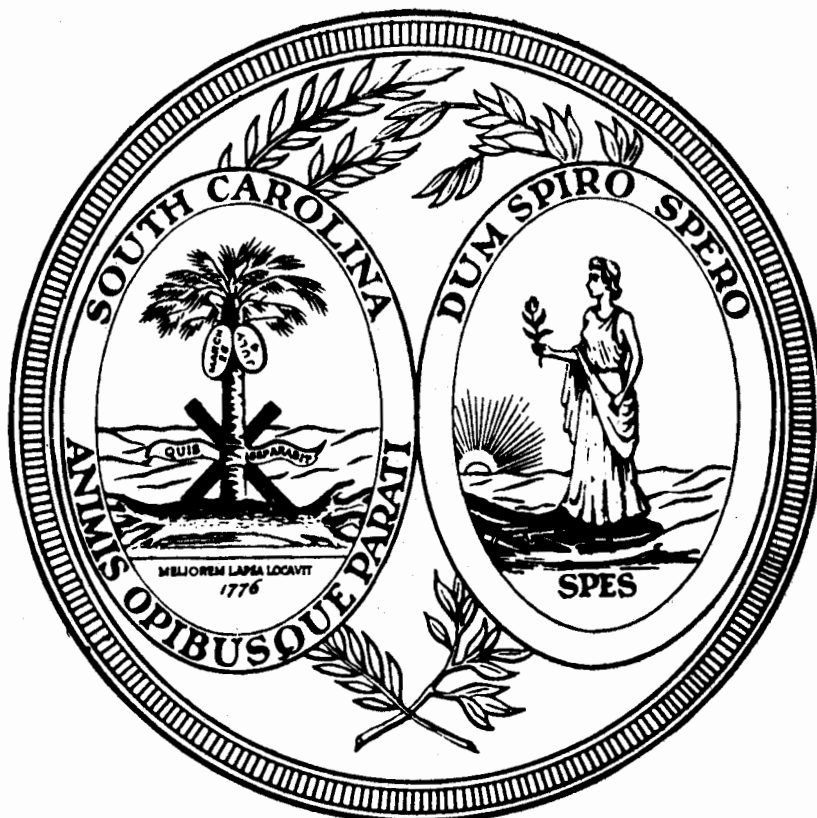

PREFACE

Checklist of South Carolina State Publications was issued by the Department of Archives and History for fiscal years 1950/51 through 1966/67 and has been issued by the South Carolina State Library* since fiscal year 1968/69. It is an annual listing of those State publications received by the South Carolina State Library.

Materials are listed according to the classification system devised for South Carolina State publications, which is in general an alphabetical arrangement by key word in the issuing agency and in the publication title.

Most items are available on interlibrary loan from the South Carolina State Library. Individual items desired for permanent retention, except those from the General Assembly, should be requested from the issuing agency. General Assembly publications may be purchased from the following:
