WHEREAS, community action agencies offer a variety of services to our residents, including employment, education, housing, income management, health, nutrition, energy, and general emergency assistance; and

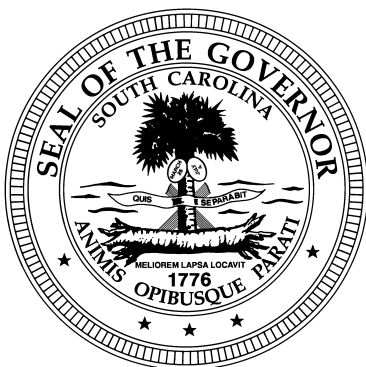
