

# Clarendon County Recycling Centers

Clarendon County operates **12 recycling centers** with attendants trained to assist you with recyclables and household garbage. These centers **ARE NOT FOR COMMERCIAL USE**, but for the residents of Clarendon County. **THE LANDFILL – Site L** – is for residential and commercial use.

**Sites 1-4** are OPEN Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

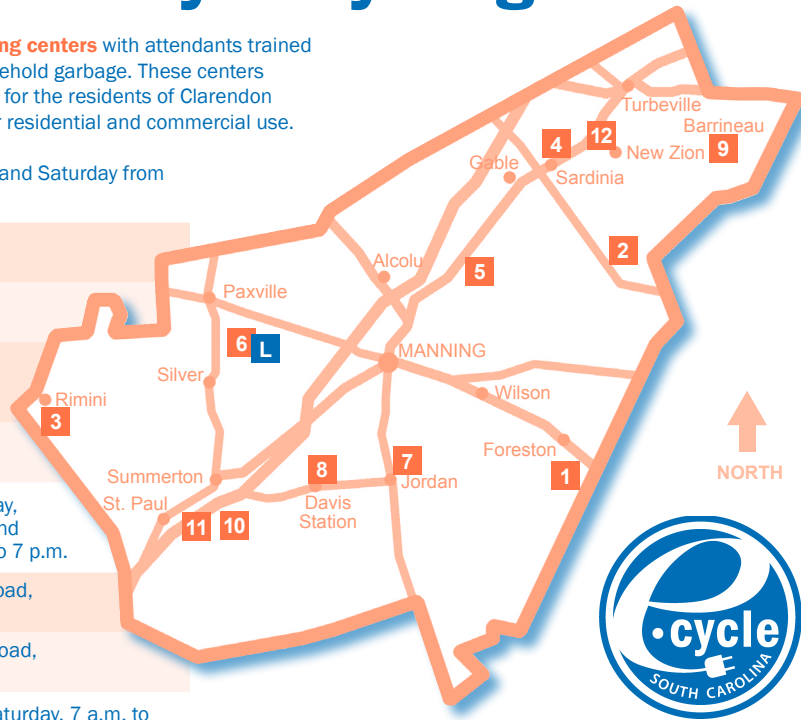

## Electronics Recycling

Unwanted household electronics (e-waste) are now accepted **ONLY** at the following recycling centers – **Davis Station, Jordan, June Burn, North Santee, Turbeville** and the **Landfill** – on first Saturday of each month.

Accepted e-waste includes: CD and DVD players; cell phones; computers and computer monitors; game consoles; intact televisions; keyboards and mice; microwaves; printers; stereo tuners and radios; vacuum cleaners; and video display devices.

**BATTERY RECYCLING:** Household batteries (sizes AA, AAA, C and D) are accepted at the Radio Shack in Manning. For a list of local recyclers that accept rechargeable batteries, visit [www.call2recycle.org](http://www.call2recycle.org).

**FLUORESCENT BULB RECYCLING:** Participating Lowe's and The Home Depot stores accept household fluorescent bulbs for recycling.














## Accepted for Disposal ...

The following items are accepted for disposal at all Clarendon County Recycling Centers.

- **Furniture** (e.g., chairs, sofas, mattresses)
- **Household garbage**
- **Yard trimmings** (e.g., leaves, tree limbs, shrubs)  
NOTE: Limbs should not exceed 6 feet in length nor 6 inches in diameter. Do not mix garbage or recyclables with yard trimmings.

## Preparing Your Recyclables ...

- Separate recyclables from your household garbage.
- Rinse bottles, cans and jars.
- Flatten cardboard, aluminum cans and plastic bottles to help save space.
- Keep paper, magazines and cardboard clean and dry.
- At the recycling centers, place recyclables in the correct containers.

## More to Know ...

- **ANTIFREEZE:** DO NOT put antifreeze in any used motor oil collection tank.
- **CARDBOARD:** Cardboard with a wax finish IS NOT accepted for recycling.
- **COOKING OIL** is accepted from HOUSEHOLDS ONLY. Limit 5 gallons per visit.
- **GLASS:** Window glass, pottery, porcelain and china ARE NOT accepted.
- **TIRES:** Rims must be removed. Oversized tires ARE NOT accepted. Limit four per visit.
- **USED MOTOR OIL:** The following petroleum products ARE ACCEPTED and may be put into used oil collection tanks: motor oil, hydraulic fluid, gear oil, diesel fuel, fuel oil, kerosene, automatic transmission fluid and power steering fluid. Limit 5 gallons per visit.
