This workshop will look at the Guidelines for Children's Services in South Carolina recently drafted by a Task Force of librarians. Participants will have the opportunity to comment on the guidelines and will consider ways they may be used in planning for children's services. Specific and constructive suggestions for assessing needs of the community, writing goals and objectives and taking steps toward implementation of these goals will be made.

Who Should Attend:

Children's librarians who are responsible for planning and carrying out the library's service to children; directors; other administrators such as heads of extension departments.

Workshop Leaders:

Margaret Bush: Assistant Professor, Simmons College, Graduate School of Library and Information Science. Ms. Bush served as the chair of the ALA/ALSC Task Force on Competencies for Librarians Serving Children in Public Libraries and has wide experience in public library service to children.

Dr. Patricia Feehan: Assistant Professor, University of South Carolina, College of Library and Information Science. Dr. Feehan has served as a director of a public library, as a children's librarian and as a state consultant for youth services. She is well known as a workshop leader in South Carolina.

For librarians staying overnight, there will be time after dinner (on your own) for an exchange of ideas for puppet shows with short demonstrations by several librarians who regularly use puppets.
