Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers lightly tested. Few feeder steers sold 3.00-5.00 lower. Limited number of heifers were 6.00-8.00 lower. Steer calves 4.00-8.00 lower. Heifers calves sold 8.00-10.00 lower. Quality plain to average. Weigh-ups average to full. Cattle futures improved late last week but not near enough to make many confident the market has turned the corner. Slaughter cattle sold sharply lower and beef prices declined as well. Western Oklahoma did receive some much needed rain over the weekend, however some of it fell hard enough that a few wheat pastures may need replanting. Supply included 57 percent over 600 lbs and 39 percent heifers.
