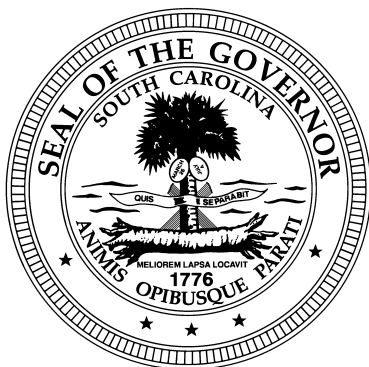
WHEREAS, the annual observance of Building Safety Week calls attention to the life safety services provided by local and state building departments and by federal agencies; and
